Mesa Village to Receive Traffic Signal at Corner of Mesa Verde Ranch Road and Charles T. Lee Memorial Relief Route

Alamogordo, N.M. The New Mexico Department of Transportation has distributed bid documents for the construction of a traffic light at the corner of Mesa Verde Ranch Road and the Charles T. Lee Memorial Relief Route. The project will bid on December 21, 2007, and will include signalization, lighting, roadway reconstruction, sidewalk construction, and curb and gutter. The project will be in conjunction with work at the Relief Route and 10th Street. Work is to be completed in 90 calendar days.

The traffic signal will help eliminate future traffic concerns in the area due to the continuing growth and development of the Mesa Village Master Planned Community. Traffic counts are expected to increase dramatically in the area with the addition of PreCheck, Allen Theatres, and the USDA Service Center. The traffic signal will increase safety for both residents of the community and visitors to the commercial businesses.
